904. PUBLIC ATTENDANCE AT SCHOOL EVENTS

Purpose

The Board welcomes the public at activities and events sponsored by the school district, but the Board also acknowledges its duty to maintain order and preserve school facilities during such events.

Definition

For purposes of this policy, tobacco includes a lighted or unlighted cigarette, cigar and pipe; other smoking products including but not limited to electronic cigarettes or smoking devices, personal vaporizers or electronic delivery systems; chemicals or devices that produce the same flavor or physical effect of nicotine substances; or material and smokeless tobacco in any form. Authority

The Board has the authority to prohibit at a school event the attendance of any individual whose conduct may constitute a disruption. The Board prohibits gambling, except as specifically authorized by Policy 915 Small Games of Chance; and the possession and use of controlled substances, alcoholic beverages and weapons on school premises. Guidelines

A schedule of fees for attendance at school events shall be prepared by the Superintendent or designee.

Tobacco Use

The Board prohibits tobacco use by any persons in its school buildings and on any property, buses, vans and vehicles that are owned, leased or controlled by the school district. [4] [1]

The district shall annually notify staff, parents/guardians and members of the public about the district's tobacco use policy by publishing such in handbooks, newsletters, posted notices, and other efficient methods.

The Superintendent or designee may report incidents involving the sale of tobacco to minors by any person on school property, at any school-sponsored activity or on a conveyance providing

transportation to or from a school or school-sponsored activity to the local police department that has jurisdiction over the school's property, in accordance with state law and regulations, the procedures set forth in the memorandum of understanding with local law enforcement and Board policies. In accordance with state law, the Superintendent shall annually, by July 31, report all incidents of possession, use or sale of tobacco by any person on school property to the Office for Safe Schools on the required form. [6] [10]
