DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING JR.'S GOAL FOR OUR WORLD IN OUR COMMUNITY

Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. believed in a world where "all people can share in the wealth of the earth" without poverty, hunger, homelessness, racism, discrimination, or reliance on military power to settle disputes (The King Center). He named this idea the "Beloved Community," which became his goal for our world. While recognizing that human conflict is inevitable, he, alongside many others, believes that a world built on the basis of agape love and acceptance is a possibility if the community values the same goals.

## AGAPE LOVE

Dr. King described Agape love as "an overflowing love which is purely spontaneous, unmotivated, groundless, and creative." agape love is "love seeking to preserve and create community" because it is right, reguardless of the person, time, or place (The King Center).
