Cassie: Yeah.

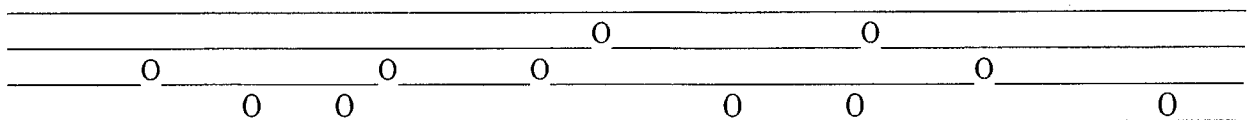
Director: NOW! If we want to find that destiny that you might have, then we should start are audition. First up we have (Long quiet pause) Uh. Joey!

Jennie: You got one of the younger boys. He has a few solos and also a couple lines!

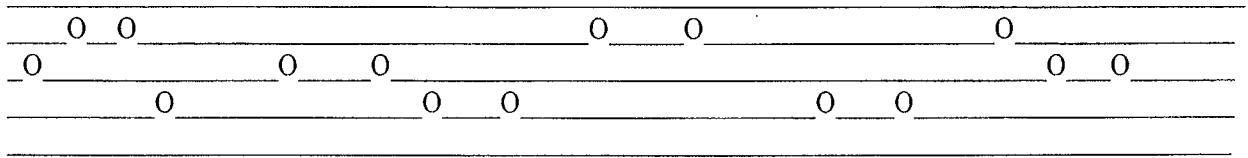
