

The Carlisle Area School District is seeing changes in our enrollment, and as a result we are beginning a significant initiative to explore the future of our Kindergarten through 8th grade school buildings. Carlisle Area School District is experiencing a significant amount of housing growth in the north side of the district. As we prepare for an influx of students in the short and long term, we have recommitted to the work that was begun years ago to examine our elementary program and needs – including some models we're exploring for future renovations and/or construction. We have analyzed student-growth predictions and conducted a feasibility study of our facilities. We have also met with the architects at Crabtree and Rohrbaugh who specialize in school renovations, additions, and construction.

We are expanding our facilities committee to include faculty and staff, parents, and community members. Over the course of the summer, the committee will meet in person on the following dates and times:

June 2nd - 8:30 - 11:30 a.m. June 26th - 9:00 a.m. - noon July 10th - noon - 3:00 p.m. July 31st - 9:00 a.m. - noon August 14th - noon - 3:00 p.m. August 25th - noon - 3:00 p.m.
