Who Can Participate?

All students in the 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th grades who attend public, private or parochial schools are eligible to enter.

Annual Themes:

2017-2018: "Why is the Constitution important to me?"

2018-2019: "Why should you say 'Thank you' to a Veteran?"

2019-2020: "What does freedom mean to me?"

2020-2021: "What do I think of when I see the American flag?" **2021-2022:** "Why should we honor and respect our Veterans?"

Contest Rules:

- All students must address the theme.
- All essays may be written in ink, typed or produced on a computer.
- ☑ 6th Grade students should submit essays of 200 words or less.
- Th and 8th Grade students should submit essays of 300 words or less.
- 9th and 10th Grade students should submit essays of 400 words or less.
- 11th and 12th Grade students should submit essays of 500 words or less.
- All national entries must be postmarked by July 1. Local and state deadlines may vary.
