Welcome to the Advanced Placement United States History class! To prepare for the 2022-23 class this fall, there will be a few, easy online assignments to complete over the summer prior to the first week of school.

The class textbook is now **available at the McGowan Guidance Office**. Make sure you pick up a copy of the Brinkley textbook before departing from school or at some point over the summer months. You will need this in order to complete the assignments.

I will mail out more information to you regarding the online assignments later this summer once the course can be set up on the Schoology platform. I need to wait until the turnover on July 1st. You should expect to receive something from me in the mail after this point.

We will spend the entire first week of school reviewing Period #1 (1492-1607). This part of AP U.S. History comprises only about 3% of the overall end-of-course exam. We will complete the Period #1 Exam the second week of school. The better prepared the online summer assignments are, the more likely you will be able to contribute to the discussion in class the first week and a solid score on the first exam.
