We will spend the entire first week of school reviewing Period #1 (1492-1607). This part of AP U.S. History comprises only about 3% of the overall end-of-course exam. The better prepared the online summer assignments are the more likely you will be able to contribute to the discussion in class the first week and a solid score on the first exam.
